Our Commitment to Our Donors

We will not sell, share or trade our donors' names or personal information with any other entity, nor send mailings to our donors on behalf of other organizations. This policy applies to all information received by Rebuilding Together Sandoval County, both online and offline, on any Platform ("Platform", includes the Rebuilding Together Sandoval County website), as well as any electronic, written, or oral communications.

Rebuilding Together Sandoval County ("RTSC") is committed to protecting the privacy of visitors to its website ("Site"). This privacy policy ("Policy") governs the use of the personal information you provide when you visit our Site ("Your Information").

By using this Site, you accept this Policy. RTSC reserves the right to modify this Policy at any time by posting a notice on the Site's home page. Your use of the Site after the notice is posted indicates that you agree to the changes. In addition, if RTSC considers it appropriate, it may also provide additional notice of significant changes. This Policy and our [Terms of Use](#) (together, "Agreement") govern your use of this Site, so please be sure to read the entire Agreement.

Collection of Your Information

RTSC collects Your Information (which may include your name, physical and email addresses and so forth) on the Site only when you voluntarily submit it. For example, we collect Your Information when you register to receive our **[Re]Builder News** updates or when you submit user content, such as a comment on a blog.

For homeowners requesting services, RTSC may share homeowner information collected through this website with Rebuilding Together, Inc. In addition, RTSC may share homeowner information with other RTSC partnering organizations. RTSC will not sell or publicly share individual homeowner information without the consent of the homeowner, except as permitted by the privacy policy.

RTSC also may share volunteer data collected through the website with Rebuilding Together, Inc. RTSC will not sell or publicly share individual volunteer information without the consent of the volunteer, except as permitted by the privacy policy.

Use and Disclosure of Your Information

We use Your Information for the purposes for which you provide it. For example, if you register to receive our **[Re]Builder News**, we use Your Information to create your account and to send you newsletter and other updates. If you do not wish to receive these communications, you can opt out by contacting us at info@rebuildnm.org or by selecting the "Unsubscribe" option on our email communications to you.

Our service providers, such as those who facilitate features of the Site for us, may have access to Your Information. We will not share, rent, or sell Your Information to any third parties for marketing or other commercial purposes.

RTSC will not sell, trade or share a donor's personal information with anyone else, nor send donor mailings on behalf of other organizations. RTSC will only share personal information if the donor has given RTSC explicit permission to do so.

RTSC strives to protect the transmission of Your Information, but no transmission of data is completely secure, and submission is at your risk. Please remember that any information you share in public areas becomes public, and therefore this Privacy Policy does not apply to any information you choose to make public. Please be careful about what you disclose, and do not post any personal information that you expect to keep private.

Site Traffic

RTSC uses cookies and other means to collect anonymous data from Site visitors for the purpose of gathering information on how visitors use the Site so that we may enhance your experience and improve the Site's functionality. "Cookies" are small files downloaded to your hard drive that enable your browser to save and recall information. RTP does not link the anonymous data collected on the Site to the personal information of an individual visitor.

Security

RTSC takes precautions to host and maintain the Site in a secure manner and to safeguard it from unauthorized access. For example, we protect your account information with passwords and firewalls. Neither RTSC nor its service providers, however, can guarantee that any transmission of personal information over the internet is secure, and you use the Site at your own risk.

Children

RTSC does not knowingly collect information on the Site from children under the age of 13. If we ever learn that we have collected any personally identifiable information from a child under the age of 13 without verification of parental consent, we will delete that information.
